not related to public business"; (3)"To consider the acquisition of real property for a public				
purpose and matters directly related thereto; (4)":To consider a matter that concerns the				
proposal for a business or industrial organization to locate, expand, or remain in the State;				
(5)"To consider the investment of public funds"; (6)"To consider the marketing of public				
securities; (7)"To consult with counsel to obtain legal advice"; (8)"To consult with staff,				
consultants or other individuals about pending or potential litigation"; (9)"To conduct collective				
bargaining negotiations or consider matters that relate to the negotiations; (10)"To discuss				
public security, if the public body determines that public discussion would constitute a risk to the public				
or to public security, including: (i) the deployment of fire and police services and staff; and (ii) the				
development and implementation of emergency plans"; (11)"To prepare, administer, or grade a				
scholastic, licensing, or qualifying examination"; (12)"To conduct or discuss an investigative				
proceeding on actual or criminal conduct"; (13)"To comply with specific constitutional,				
statutory, or judicially imposed requirement that prevents public disclosures about a particular				
proceeding or matter"; (14)"Before a contract is awarded or bids are opened, to discuss a				
matter directly related to a negotiating strategy or the contents of a bid or proposal, if public discussion				
or disclosure would adversely impact the ability of the public body to participate in the competitive				

bidding or proposal process"; (15)"	To discuss "security assessments or deployments relating to
information resources technology"; (ii) "ne	twork codes, encryption, security devices or vulnerability
assessments or that a governmental entity	collects or maintains to prevent, detect or investigate
criminal activity; or (iii) " deployments or in	nplementation of security personnel, critical infrastructure or
security devices."
